Dear Home School Families,

Statesville Christian School added varsity football to our athletics program in the fall of 2015. During year one we partnered with local club football programs to field a team. In year two we joined the NC Independent Schools Athletic Association (NCISAA) and had a successful season winning the state title. This past year we ended the season 9-2.

Since many of our 2017 team members were seniors, we are now re-building and have stepped away from the state conference in football. As an independent team, we have more flexibility in creating our schedule, and can include a limited number of home-school players.

We anticipate allowing up to ten boys from home-school settings to participate on both our middle and high school teams this fall. Participating players are required to pay the same athletic fees that our own students pay for football which is \$350.00. To maintain integrity and comply with state rules, we do not allow students enrolled in public schools to participate in this partnership. It is only open to a limited number of home-school slots, and to students enrolled at our school.

We will hold a special commitment meeting on Thursday, May 31, 2018 at 7:00 PM at Statesville Christian School during which time we will provide additional information. Our goal for this meeting is to get firm commitments from both Statesville Christian athletes as well as home-school students who wish to play football this fall. Our Head Coach, Todd Fox will discuss summer workouts and other essential information.
