

The School

Statesville Christian School is a college preparatory, inter-denominational Christian School. SCS was founded in 1995 as a K-5 school. Our first graduating class was in 2003. Today SCS is a K-12 school with an enrollment of 275 students. SCS admits students regardless of race, national origin, or gender.

Mission of SCS

The mission of SCS is to train students, in partnership with families, to think, live, love and lead as Christians through programs of academic excellence based upon a Biblical worldview.

Accreditation

SCS is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), AdvancEd, SACS, and the North Carolina Department of Non-Public Instruction.

Format of Day and Year

The school day consists of yearlong classes meeting every other day. Classes meet for 85 minutes per day. AP courses and select honors courses are offered as yearlong courses that meet every day. The school day is 8:00-2:50, five days a week. The year consists of a semester schedule beginning in late August and ending in late May. During the fourth week of February, high school students will be involved in "Winterim" which will include internships, specialized classes, and a mission trip.
