

## **Statesville Christian School Service Component 2007-2008**

Statesville Christian School strives to train students to think, live, love and lead. Part of that training includes requiring the students to be involved in serving others. Statesville Christian School believes this to be a critical component of applying what the students learn in the classroom. The following are the requirements for each section of the secondary school:

### ***Middle School Service Component:***

One service day will be provided for Middle School students during a school day each semester. The students will be notified of that day with the appropriate information, permission slips, etc. from the Bible teacher each semester. If students are absent from school on the day of service with the Middle School, similar service (completed individually) will need to be approved through the Bible teacher.

### ***High School Service Component:***

High school students will be expected to serve for 15 hours during the 2007-2008 school year. The service hours will count for a grade in their Bible class. Students may apply 10 of the 15 hours from a summer service opportunity prior to the school year. A minimum of 5 hours should be towards a mission or for the needy. Students are to serve with one primary organization or church for their service hours during the semester that they have Bible class. Each service opportunity needs to be pre-approved by the Bible teacher except for summer service opportunities prior to the school year.
