<p>The school day consists of a block schedule with four 80 minute block periods per day with a 30 minute Quality Resource Time before 3rd Period. AP courses are offered as year long courses. The school day is 8:00-2:45 five days a week. The year consists of a traditional two semester schedule beginning in late August and ending in late May. During the first 2 weeks in January the high school students will be involved in "Winterim" which will include internships, specialized classes and a mission trip.</p>
