Statesville Christian School Statement Regarding COVID-19

The novel coronavirus COVID-19 ("**COVID-19**"), has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is very contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact.

Statesville Christian School (SCS) has put in place preventive measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, SCS cannot guarantee or assure you that your child (which term shall include a child for whom you are the guardian) will not become infected with COVID-19 after attending classes, activities and events at, or sponsored, arranged or allowed by SCS (collectively "**School Events**"). Attending School Events could increase your child's risk of contracting COVID-19.

Parent Agreement Response:

I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk on behalf of my child that my child may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending School Events and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death.

On my behalf, and on behalf of my child, I hereby waive, release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless SCS, its officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives, of and from all claims, liabilities, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind, including without limitation reasonable attorney's fees and costs, in any way arising from or out of or relating to, directly or indirectly, COVID-19 infection of my child or me or anyone else that I or my child may come into contact with, and any effects thereof, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any School Events.
