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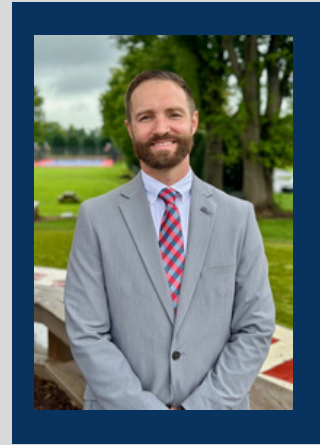

Have a wonderful weekend, and don't forget to live out our *One Another* theme in your thoughts, words, and actions.

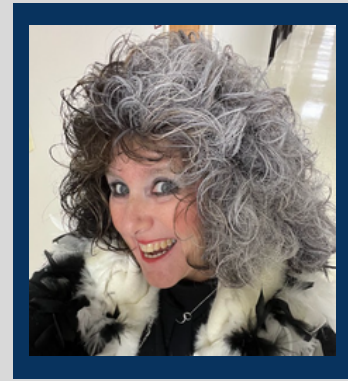

This Week's Prayer Focus:

OUTDO ONE ANOTHER IN SHOWING HONOR

"Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor (Romans 12:10)."

Brotherly affection flows from deep bonds and genuine familiarity. To show honor is basically to treat people better than they deserve and to elevate them above yourself. Yet, the key word here is "outdo" one another - not by putting yourself on a pedestal or seeking attention, but by finding ways to speak highly of someone else.

Realize that the ability to show affection and honor does not come naturally, but it is from the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. If you find it difficult to show honor, pray fervently for the Lord to provide a humbleness in your heart.

In Romans 12:1, Paul urges others to *"present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual act of worship."* Our love for and worship of God is deeply connected to how we love and treat the people around us.

Jesus provided an example in Matthew 20:16,25-28. This is the upside-down passage with phrases like *"the last will be first"* and *"the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve."* When we follow His example, we participate in a "Jesus-style competition." This kind of one-upmanship is rooted not in pride, but in humility. Our goal is to lift one another higher and set an example that draws others toward the same Christlike mindset.
