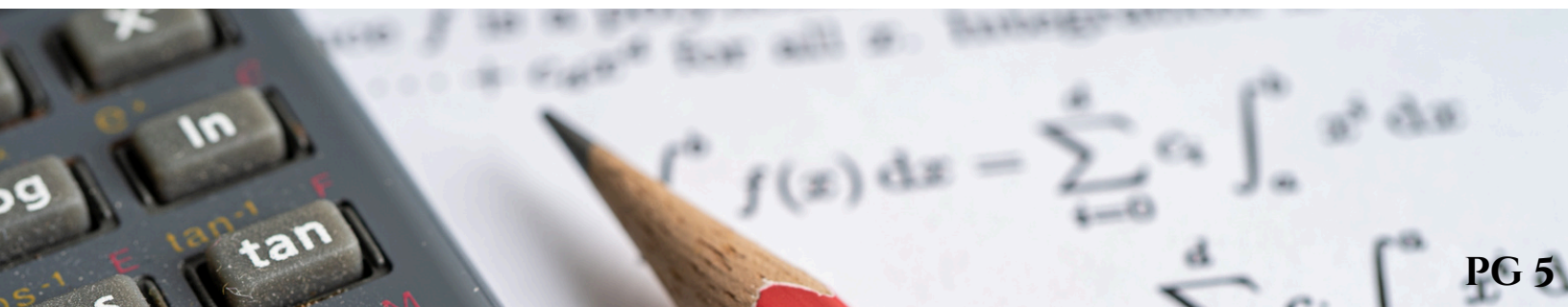
Bible and elective classes will not give final exams. Courses such as PE, Art, Theatre, Photography, and Yearbook will not have exams.
